

Young Investigators Fellowship (YIF) Guidelines

YIFs support: registration fee with all services included (double room) (see Registration page)

YIF eligibility criteria:

applicant must either be **registered as a PhD student** at an institution of higher learning or must **be within five years of obtaining his/her PhD**.

Application

Deadline for YTF applications: June 10, 2013.

Applicants must email the following to the Organizers at **ecf2013@unige.ch**.

1. **A signed letter of recommendation** from a **mentor/supervisor**, who is also entitled to confirm the status as a young scientist. On the letter coversheet please indicate your name and “ECF2013_YIF application: Recommendation letter”.
2. **An application letter**, including a 4-8 lines long answer to the following questions: Why do you consider this meeting important for you? In your opinion, what aspects of the cytoskeletal investigations will become the most important and fruitful line of research in the next 10 years? Please indicate your name and “ECF2013_YIF application: Application letter”.
3. **Your Abstract as a first author**. Please indicate your name and “ECF2013_YIF application: Abstract”.
4. **Your Curriculum Vitae**. Please indicate your name and “ECF2013_YIF application: CV”.

YIF candidates will be selected by the organizers based on eligibility and quality criteria. The answers will be send before June 25th.

After receiving the answer, please register before June 30 (deadline for registration) through the Online Registration System. In case of a positive decision, no registration fee will be asked during the registration process.
